### This fee includes:

- accommodation in carefully selected homestay accommodation on a half-board basis; residential accommodation is available at the University of East Anglia from June to September and by arrangement at certain other times.

- use of resource centre and library
- free email and Internet access and use of computer centre
- social programme – comprising evening activities and weekend excursions to places of interest e.g. Cambridge and the Norfolk Coast

**Please note:** Airport transfers are **not** included in the fees.

### Accommodation in Norwich

\* **Homestay accommodation** is provided in single study-bedrooms with carefully selected hosts. It comprises bed, breakfast & evening meal each day and light lunch (or packed lunch as appropriate) at weekends.

**Residential accommodation** is provided on campus at the University of East Anglia in single study-bedrooms with private bathroom. The accommodation is on a bed & breakfast (B&B) basis in university 'houses' or 'flats' with a shared kitchen/dining room, fully equipped for self-catering.
